# Policy and ownership

- Minimum requirements:
  - Top-down statement on the importance of Open Education
    - Preferably Board of Directors
  - Bottom-up interest, grassroots momentum
    - Early adopters
  - Early support and ownership
    - Library or Centre for Teaching and Learning
      - Access to platforms
      - Empowering agency

## Knowledge

- Challenge:
  - Open education is unknown or misunderstood, or mistaken for open access
  - Lack of knowledge breeds fear:
    - Copyright
    - Quality
    - Time and money
  - Recognition
- Solution is difficult
  - Support and guidance through promotion, workshops, information
    - "get your feet wet"
  - Clear roles:
    - Library for access to platforms and support for OER and OT
    - CTL for pedagogy, practices, teacher support
    - Copyright Information Office for questions on licenses
    - Collaborations with existing Open Science initiatives
    - University-wide approach

#### Infrastructure

- Challenge:
  - Many databases and platforms
  - Not all are equally user-friendly
  - Ownership: IT(S) vs. Library
- Library lead role
  - Explore which platforms exist
  - Decide which platforms can be supported (e.g.: git cannot be supported by our department)

### Target audience, peer review, finances

- Challenge:
  - Reaching and informing teachers
  - Reaching and informing policy makers
  - Concers
- Library lead role
  - Offer information online and in person
  - Workshops
  - Support in use of platforms
- Challenge not taken up by Utrecht Library: peer review, finances, etc.

## Workflow & responsibilities


- Challenge:
  - Hypothetical workload assumptions
  - Early adopters do not need much help
  - Who should do what?
- Library lead role
  - Support knowledge
  - Support use of the platform
  - Support promotion of OE
  - We are not an academic publisher!
- Make users responsible!
  - Peer communities and workflow in edusources for OER
  - Create their own textbooks and interactive aspects

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#### **Veterinary Online Collection**


- Collaboration between the Universities of Utrecht, Copenhagen and Helsinki
- Sharing materials through a 'professional community'
   (vakcommunity in Dutch) on edusources




Veterinary Online Collection on Edusources, screen capture 16 - 11 - 2023

#### Data Privacy Project (UU Library)

- Aim: to develop multidisciplinary knowledge of and tools about data privacy issues.
- Multiple educational deliverables: handbook, online module, knowledge clips.
